Age: I-st category: 6 - 7 - 8 years old children.

II-nd category: 9 - 10 - 11 years old children

Working technique: free.

Materials used: at option.

Size: A4

Dead-line for sending the works: February 5, 2005

Number of entries: one work is admitted for each children –not a group entry or school entry.

Artist’s address: (must be attached to the reverse side of the work)

- The name and first name of the child.
- The country, city, street, house number.
- The name of the school and the address of the school.
- The telephone number of school, fax number of school.
- The name of the teacher.

Only the works of students from SEMEP schools are accepted -not from arts schools.

The selection by the Jury of the winners of the contest will take place in March 15, 2005.

## **Prizes**

Each student will receive a participation Diploma.

For the 10 best works (from each age category) will be awarded Special Diplomas and Prizes like art albums and books about Romania in English.

The Grand Prize -the winners of the first place- as well as the guiding teachers for each category will be invited to visit for 4 days Romania, at Onesti, the place of birth and of starting in gymnastics of Nadia Comaneci.

The date of the visit will be established afterwards.

The cost of the sojourn in Romania will be supported by the organizers.

All the works will be made the object of itinerant exhibition in Bucharest, Onesti and other towns of Romanian SEMEP schools.
